Register to vote *and* vote from your home!

#1

Register or confirm your registration to vote at the Illinois Online Voter Registration Application website. Register as soon as you can because the online voter registration system will close at 11:59 p.m. on October 18, 2020.

Apply to your county election authority for a Vote by Mail ballot. If you apply before October 1, your ballot will be mailed in late September or early October to the address you specify. Your application must be received by October 29.

Your Vote by Mail ballot must be returned or postmarked no later than Election Day, November 3, 2020.

- County clerks also plan to place secure ballot drop boxes at various locations.
- If you request a mail-in ballot and do not use it, you must bring the ballot and the envelope to your voting location and turn it in so you can vote in person with a regular ballot, otherwise you will be given a provisional ballot.

No computer or smart phone? No problem.

If you voted in the last two years or recently registered to vote, a paper application for a Vote by Mail ballot will automatically be mailed to the address where you are registered.
